Add \$4.00 for each entry form to the correct entry fee amount. Fax number is (760) 946-9048. You must fax both the front and back of entry form for it to be accepted, completely filled out and signed. Notification must be received by the show secretary from PayPal that the funds have been deposited before the entry will be accepted.

The Club and/or its Show Secretary assume(s) no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, nor for entering the same dog twice.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of the entry fee for bitches in season; bitches entered for breed competition are eligible to be shown. There will be no refund of duplicate entries.

Declination of entries. The Keeshond Club of Southern California may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the KCSC or any official thereof.

If, because of extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry shall be made.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

A Recording Fee of \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (*Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, Chapter 11, Section 2.) In addition to the Recording Fee, an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be collected on each entry of each dog (with the exception of sweepstakes and multiple-dog classes), effective January 1, 2008.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

A judge who contemplates applying for additional breeds may, with prior approval, observe in the ring while regular judging is in progress.

EXHIBITOR TICKET INFORMATION

Exhibitor's identification tickets will be mailed to an exhibitor at the address given on the entry form and should be received within a reasonable time prior to the show. Exhibitors not receiving them should notify the Show Secretary at (760) 242-3320. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked "Undeliverable" will be held at the office of the Show Secretary.

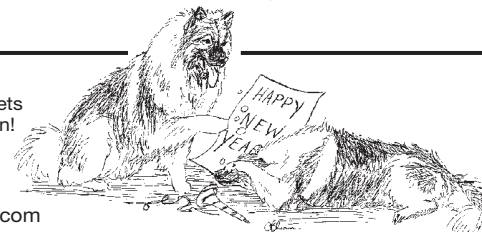

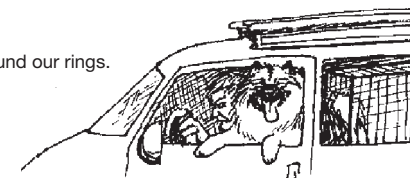

— NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS —

These Shows and Trial will be governed by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the Premium List.

— ADDITIONAL RULES —

Judging – The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of the dogs, or the handlers of the dogs, alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or its handler when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of the American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.

Trophies – Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the Show Chairman is to be advised in the event of any discrepancy.

LOSS OR DAMAGE – The management will not be responsible for the loss to or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody, and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Grooming – All grooming must be done away from the judging ring, in areas specified by the Club.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Best of Breed – Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner’s records have completed the requirements for a Championship, but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner’s records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the Championship of the dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed Competition are to be made until its Championship has been confirmed by the A.K.C.

AWARDS OF MERIT

Awarded to 10% (rounded up) of entrants in Best of Breed competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class – For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this Show or Trial. The award will be based on the merits of the two get, get only to be judged. As the judge’s decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his two get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class – For Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this Show or Trial. The award will be based on the merits of the two produce, produce only to be judged. As the judge’s decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her two produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class – For two Keeshonden with at least one common owner.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND/OR THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. - (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
